Mission

Objectives

- To provide a social, professional, and informational network.
- To encourage membership support of the *LNC Alumni Network* including but not limited to financial support, recruitment, curriculum, and program development.
- To promote and encourage alumni and members to continue expanding as community leaders.
- To connect and engage members with volunteer and leadership opportunities on local, regional and state boards and committees.

Membership Qualifications
